### Gallery 1: Guardians Against Evil Dreams, Jebah Baum

Like the striations of an abraded cliff face or the battered and scarred surface of a bronze age shield, Jebah Baum's recent work evokes a sense of resistance. Baum harvests and makes his own materials, thus imbuing his art with an intensely physical presence. The accumulated gestural marks in his sculptures and works on paper reflect a rigorous engagement with form, but nothing appears to be in stasis and his repeated overlaying of shapes, lines and textures creates a bulwark against direct association.

When they met at the Virginia Center for Creative arts in 2020, composer Steven Takasugi and visual artist Jebah Baum began a rich cross disciplinary collaboration that has resulted in several dynamic exhibitions of their work together. This will be their third presentation at BAU Gallery. It includes an idiosyncratic grouping of crushed music stands that are instantly recognizable, although they no longer serve their intended purpose. These, now *sculptural objects* will also serve as percussion instruments in the premier of a new Takasugi composition in Melbourne, Australia in 2025.


