Daniel Berlin's exhibit at the BAU gallery in Beacon, NY is titled "Weightless", a reference to the buoyancy of thought freed from conceptual quicksand. The show includes painting and monotypes that keep an eye out for the occasional point of "recognition". Berlin encourages himself (and the viewer) to an authentic moment.

Allegory and Apparatus

Lukas Milanak applies the do-it-yourself ethos to science and engineering, inventing playful sculptures and art-making machines by breathing life into found objects with elemental materials like wood, steel and handblown glass. *Allegory and Apparatus* will feature recent work ranging from the curious to the absurd. Through the reuse and reinvention of everyday materials, Milanak depicts an age where the experimental spirit of alchemy and curiosity is alive and well.
